AM Cover Art Call for Submissions

Have you ever been inspired by an experience in a medical school or teaching hospital to create a piece of artwork? *Academic Medicine* is seeking submissions of original artwork of any visual medium to be featured on the cover of the journal. Submissions should be inspired by some aspect of the "academic medicine experience" – for example, learning how to be a physician or scientist, caring for patients, exploring research questions, making a new discovery, teaching, or being sick in a teaching hospital. Submissions may reflect such experiences from any perspective – teacher or learner, patient or caregiver, researcher or human participant in an experiment. Please note that this is a permanent, ongoing feature with no deadline. Artwork may be submitted at any time for this feature.

Please note that you have the option of submitting a related Teaching and Learning Moment (TLM) as a narrative companion to your artwork. Although it is not a required component of a Cover Art submission, a TLM can help explain the connection between your work and your "academic medicine experience." The related narrative should adhere to TLM submission guidelines, which are found in our Complete Instructions for Authors: (<http://journals.lww.com/academicmedicine/Pages/InstructionsforAuthors.aspx#teachingandlearningmoments>). Based on the individual strength of related artwork and TLMs, we may occasionally choose to publish one without the other.

Instructions for Submitting Cover Art

1. To submit art to *Academic Medicine*, go to Editorial Manager. If you do not already have an account, click "Register."
2. When you've logged into your account and chosen to submit a new manuscript, select "Cover Art" as the manuscript type.
3. Follow the prompts to enter all required information on your submission form. (In the Abstract field, simply enter, "No abstract required.")
4. The final step before submission is uploading your files. Upload your image file(s) according to the specifications below, as well as a Microsoft Word file of your TLM essay if you have chosen to submit one. The uploaded files will be combined in a single PDF, but we will be able to access each source file individually.
