Continuing Medical Education (CME) at UC Davis is pleased to be able to offer UC Davis students and residents the opportunity to attend CME courses in the Sacramento area. We also want to make you aware of other modalities of CME that you, as a future physician, will be able to utilize in your practice.

Consistent with our mission, we believe that continuing medical education should encompass a lifetime learning experience. As a medical student and resident and, finally, as a physician you will maintain maximum effectiveness as a health-care provider in our community through educational opportunities such as those listed in this handbook.

To encourage you to attend, we have developed a simple procedure for registration: you need only come to the program and sign in. Preregistration is NOT required. There is NO COST to you.

Procedure for Attending

There is no cost to you or your department.

Pre-registration is not necessary; check in is required at the site of the program.

Bring your name badge with you; when you arrive at the facility, sign up at the registration desk of the program.

You will receive a CME name tag for admittance to the function; you will also receive a course packet with pertinent information about the course, as well as paper for note taking.

If the seminar has additional course syllabi, you will be given one at no cost by the meeting planner.
