

DEAN'S AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

Nomination Deadline: December 28, 2009

The purpose of the award is to reward the outstanding performance of a faculty member and to acknowledge their contribution as a transformative leader in our collegial community. The nominee's dedication to one of the mission areas is a focused and compelling example that exemplifies and aligns our community with our mission of discovering and sharing knowledge to advance health.

Nomination criteria

- Education – provides outstanding learning opportunities
 - utilizes teaching skills to provide a dynamic and integrated curriculum to train the next generation of physicians and medical researchers
 - encourages life-long learning
 - integrates technologies to enhance educational programs and expand teaching setting
 - innovation
 - leadership

- Research – makes high-impact discoveries
 - guides innovative research program(s)
 - exemplifies and emphasizes collaboration, team-based approach
 - dedication to being an outstanding research mentor
 - innovation
 - leadership

- Clinical Care – provides high-quality patient-oriented services
 - offers consistent, culturally competent, compassionate care to all patients
 - optimizes clinical services through academic environment and research
 - delivers patient-oriented services that respond to the compelling needs of our community
 - innovation
 - leadership

- Community – enhances the quality of life of our local and regional communities
 - participates in community organizations and volunteerism
 - enhances relations with community partners by encouraging involvement and support of health system programs
 - promote community health through advocacy and impact on health-care public policy
 - innovation
 - leadership

Eligibility

All UC Davis School of Medicine faculty (Ladder, In Residence, Clinical X, HSCP and Adjunct) are eligible to be nominated for the Dean's Award for Excellence. Up to four awards will be given for Excellence, one in each of the following mission areas: Education/Teaching, Research, Clinical Care and Community Engagement.

Nomination Procedures and Guidelines

A nomination consists of a brief form that describes the candidate's outstanding performance activities. Additional letters of support may be submitted but are not required.
