The CHT is one of the University of California's premiere facilities for advancing innovation in clinical telehealth, health education and research. This tour will provide interactive demonstrations and a look at how technologies are being integrated into the UC Davis Schools of Health curriculum.

Basic Registration (required) – \$25 per adult (children free)

Basic Registration includes: materials, tours, presentations (not including fee for CME credit), parking, hospitality area refreshments, the All Alumni Welcome Reception and Saturday afternoon intercampus (Davis/Sacramento) shuttle service.




