1. WIMHS DEPARTMENT LIAISON PROGRAM – UPDATE FROM DIRECTOR, DR. MELISSA BAUMAN

"WIMHS serves a vital role in creating a strong network of advocates focused on promoting the success of women in all roles within academic medicine," said Dr. Allison Brashear, dean of the UC Davis School of Medicine. "This is critical to fostering the next generation of successful women researchers and practitioners here at the School of Medicine."

Last year our Women in Medicine and Health Sciences (WIMHS) program launched a new Departmental Liaison (DL) program to expand outreach and better support women's careers in academic health across the 19 clinical and 7 academic departments at the UC Davis School of Medicine and the Betty Irene Moore School of Nursing. Faculty with an interest in supporting diversity in STEMM were encouraged to self-nominate to serve as the DL for their department:


- Identify department-specific needs to guide WIMHS initiatives
- Inform the department of upcoming WIMHS activities
- Identify collaborative opportunities with home department
- Represent WIMHS at the department level for faculty recruitment

Our recruitment strategies exceed our initial goal of identifying DLs for 10 departments in this first year, and we now have DLs serving 19 of 26 departments/schools within the first 12 months of the program. DLs met quarterly and were provided with career development training focused on career advancement strategies, networking and negotiation skills. Each department was also provided a small program award to support women's careers in academic medicine at the department level. The proposed projects included department-level social networking opportunities, conference attendance, invited speakers, workshops etc. Progress was tracked through individual meetings with the WIMHS Director and presented to UC Davis Health Leadership in a virtual meeting in June. Examples included:

Dr. Maija Kiuru, DL for Dermatology, organized a four part career development series for trainees and faculty in her department that covered topics related to leadership, negotiation skills, and advancement.



Megan Dennis, Rose Dixon, Ele Grande, Anna La Torre representing Biochemistry, Physiology, Pharmacology and Anatomy, pooled their resources (and received matching funds from their departments!) to organize an "Inaugural Meeting of the Basic Sciences Departments Chapter of WIMHS featuring a webinar presentation "Women and the Academic Career – What works, what doesn't."

Aizenberg. Several universities have since contacted WIMHS to learn more about the DL program and establish similar outreach efforts at their home university.



"The WIMHS Departmental Liaison program has made impressive inroads identifying department-specific needs, providing professional development training and expanding collaboration opportunities," said Dr. Brashear. "I look forward to seeing the program grow and continue to benefit women not only in the School of Medicine, but throughout our health system."
