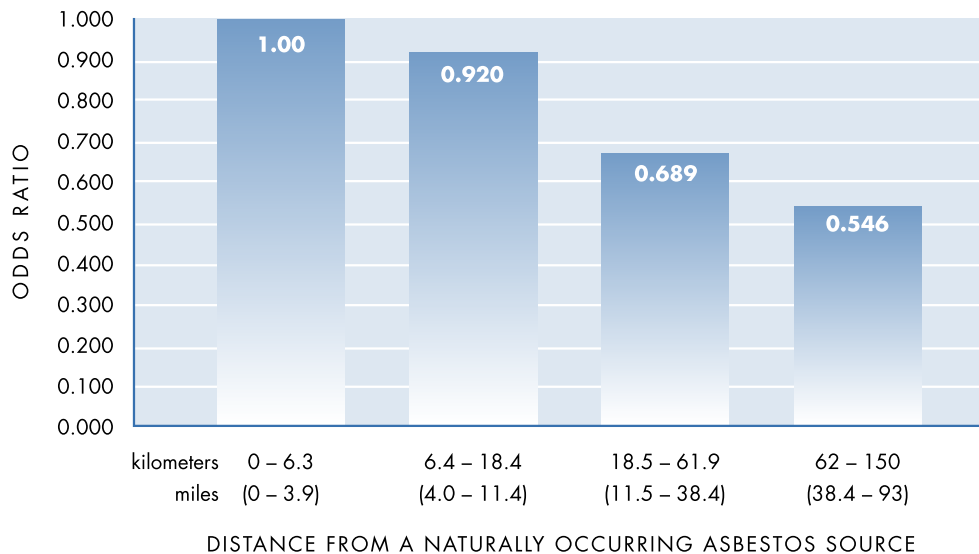


## The closer you live to a source of naturally occurring asbestos, the greater your odds of developing mesothelioma



### What does this chart mean?

Those who live 62 to 150 kilometers (38.4 to 93 miles) from a source of asbestos have about half the odds of developing mesothelioma compared with those who live within 6.3 kilometers (3.9 miles) of the source.

Those who live 18.5 to 61.9 kilometers (11.5 to 38.4 miles) from an asbestos source have about two-thirds the odds of developing mesothelioma compared with those who live within 6.3 kilometers (3.9 miles) of the source.

Those who live 6.4 to 18.4 kilometers (4.0 to 11.4 miles) from an asbestos source have about nine-tenths the odds of developing mesothelioma compared with those who live within 6.3 kilometers (3.9 miles) of the source.

If the odds of having mesothelioma are 1 in 100,000 per year\* for people living within 3.9 miles of an asbestos source, then the odds are:

- 0.92 in 100,000 for those living 4.0 to 11.4 miles from the source
- 0.689 in 100,000 for those living 11.5 to 38.4 miles from the source, and
- 0.546 in 100,000 (or 1 in 200,000) for those living 38.4 to 93 miles away
