Bonnie Wakefield's "Using Technology to Manage Chronic Illness in Older Adults at Home," describes a series of studies evaluating use of remote monitoring to allow older adults to manage chronic illness and remain in their homes. Wakefield was appointed associate research professor for the Sinclair School of Nursing at the University of Missouri in fall 2005. She holds a master's degree and doctorate from the University of Iowa College of Nursing. She also serves as director of health services research and development at Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans' Hospital in Columbia, Mo. Her work experience includes 22 years at the Iowa City VA Medical Center in Iowa City, Iowa, where she currently serves as a senior scientist for VA Health Services Research & Development Center for Implementation of Innovative Strategies in Practice.
