LAPTOP CONNECTION - HDMI

- Using the cubby, connect **hdmi** cable to your laptop
- Power on laptop
- If your presentation has audio, connect the audio cable to your laptop as well.
- On the control panel A, press
 hdmi (press button for 30 sec)
- Put your laptop in presenter
 mode (refer to your user guide

for instructions)

If you have audio, configure your audio on your laptop. <u>Not all laptops have the ability</u> to send audio using hdmi. Control house audio using the volume controls on control panel A.

PC AND VIDEOCONFERENCE

- On the control panel A, press
 Display 1 On
- On the control panel A, press **PC** (press button for 30 sec)
- Sign onto the computer using the wireless keyboard and mouse
- Launch PowerPoint and put in presenter mode. (During ECHO, Zoom is used and the presentation will be automatically transmitted to external sites.
- On the control panel A, press
 Display 2 On
- Using the LifeSize mouse, press the yellow directory button to make a video call to the computer using the mouse.
