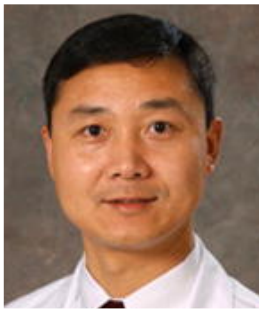


## Chong-Xian Pan, M.D., Ph.D.
