Clinical Interests Robert M. Szabo is one of the country's leading hand surgeons. His clinical interests include hand and upper-extremity problems such as brachial plexus and peripheral nerve surgery; shoulder, elbow and wrist joint replacements; wrist reconstruction, including arthroscopy; congenital deformities, including Ilizarov reconstructions; tumors; and microvascular reconstructive free tissue transfers.

Dr. Szabo is an editorial board member of The Journal of Wrist, an editorial board member of Journal of Orthopaedic Trauma, and an editorial board member of the Journal of Surgical Orthopaedic Advances. His research interests include nerve compression lesions, nerve repair and regeneration biology, tendon healing and adhesion formation, and epidemiology of repetitive trauma and injury prevention.
