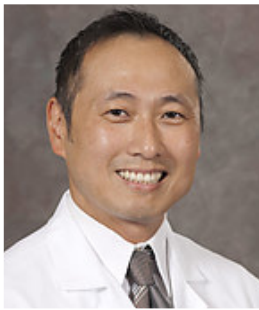


## David Mach, D.O.
