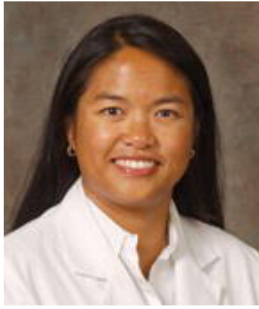




Emily Rose Andrada, M.D.
