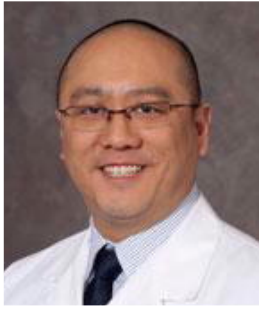


Edward Kim, M.D., Ph.D.
