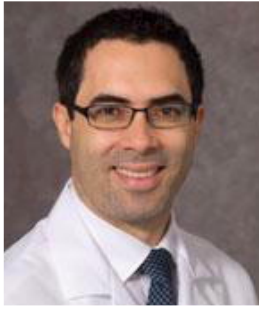


Edwin Alexander Alvarez, M.D.
