Knee surgeries include Unicompartmental knee replacements and Patello-femoral replacements. Dr. Pereira has extensive experience in using computer navigation for both hip and knee replacements. He has an avid interest in treating patients with infections following joint replacements. Dr. Pereira's research focuses on patient outcomes of hip and knee replacements and biomechanics of implants. He has a special interest in Computer aided Surgery from digital templating to computer navigation. He is also keen on methods to reduce post-op infections, early and robust diagnosis of infections and effective methods to eradicate them.
