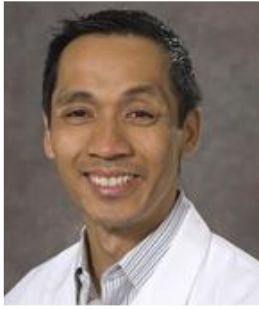




Jay Michael S Balagtas, M.D.
