Mark Avdalovic is a pulmonary and critical care medicine physician and professor of clinical medicine at UC Davis Health. He provides clinical oversight and leadership as medical director of two telehealth service lines through the UC Davis Center for Health and Technology, including video visits and eConsults. He is vice chair of the department of internal medicine and medical director for the advanced lung disease and pulmonary hypertension program.

Avdalovic serves as director for the region's first Post-COVID-19 Clinic, which provides streamlined, comprehensive care for long-haul patients who experience lingering respiratory symptoms from the coronavirus.

Avdalovic is a leader in integrating technology and clinical quality improvement; most recently with direct-to-consumer applications. Avdalovic's areas of clinical interest include COPD and pulmonary hypertension. He uses a unique animal model of COPD to study the mechanism of vascular remodeling in the lung as part of wound healing and repair. He is very active in the clinical and research applications of the electronic health record and has worked to develop a comprehensive registry of COPD patients at UC Davis Health. He has authored and co-authored publications and spoken at major conferences on COPD.

Avdalovic earned his doctor of medicine degree from the Medical College of Wisconsin and his bachelor's degree from the University of California, Santa Barbara. He completed his internal medicine residency and pulmonary and critical care fellowship at the University of California, Davis.
