## Who can participate?

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- We need participants of all ages, infants, pre-school and school-aged children, teens and adults
- Individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Chromosome 22q11.2 Deletion Syndrome, Fragile X Syndrome, and Down Syndrome
- Individuals who are typically developing

## What should I expect?

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### **This varies from study to study, but may include:**

- Research assessments by a team of professionals using a range of methods including standardized assessments, IQ and behavioral testing
- Gain access to experimental treatments that are only available to research study participants
- You may get a picture taken of your brain (fMRI or MRI scans)

## What else can be expected?

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- Results of research assessments, as well as feedback on your child's development
- Contributing to advancing science and improving the health of future generations
